

Fairview Loop Rehabilitation Project No. 51774

Project Scope

The State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is beginning design effort for a project to rehabilitate Fairview Loop Road from its connection with Parks Highway on the east to its connection with Knik-Goose Bay Road on the west. The 11-mile project will result in a restored roadbed with possibly wider lanes, shoulders and/or minor realignment depending on motor vehicle crash history.

The project is State funded with \$22 Million in general obligation bonds approved by the voters in Nov. 2008. If the geometry and right of way needs exceed the \$22 M budget, the project scope will be reduced to stay within the funds appropriated.

The Legislature also appropriated \$4.5 million dollars with the 2010 Capitol Budget to add 2.5 miles of paved, multi-purpose trail to the project scope.



Current Status

The right of way surveying has been underway since late summer 2009. This work is nearing completion. The traffic safety analysis and speed studies are underway and the design engineers are developing base mapping in preparation for the design work starting later this summer.

In addition to the engineering and surveying, the team has begun to reach out to the public. An important part of any project is to inform those most affected by the project and seek their local knowledge and insight. The input leads to a better design.

Once the initial public input is received, the design team's effort will begin in earnest. But public comment and input will be accepted throughout the design process. So let us know if you want to receive information about the project. You can do this in several ways:
