



Glenn Highway MP 34-42 Reconstruction

Parks Highway to Old Glenn Highway

FACT SHEET

The Glenn Highway MP 34-42 Reconstruction, Parks Highway to Old Glenn Highway, project will reconstruct the Glenn Highway from milepost 34 to 42 to accommodate existing and future traffic. A divided four-lane facility is proposed, with partial control of access. Partial control would provide median breaks at important intersections, but minimize driveway access. The proposed facility would consist of two 12-foot lanes in each direction, 8-foot outer shoulders, 4-foot inner shoulders, and a 32-foot-wide depressed median. A frontage road would be constructed on the west side of the highway between Cienna Avenue and South Colony Way.

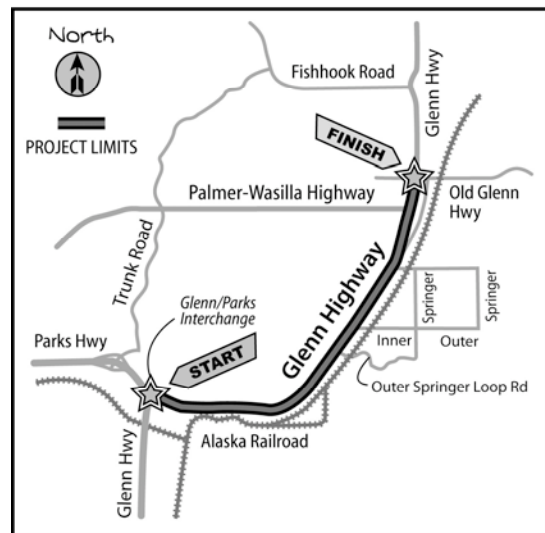
Current Status

This project is in the early design phase, which includes a re-evaluation of the section from milepost 34 to 42 of the 1993 *Glenn Highway Parks MP35 to MP 109 Environmental Assessment*. The re-evaluation may result in an amendment to the current environmental assessment that outlines how impacts will be mitigated. Or it may require an entirely new environmental assessment. The team will complete traffic analysis, examine changes in the area such as recent land development, and examine whether the project will affect any historic sites.

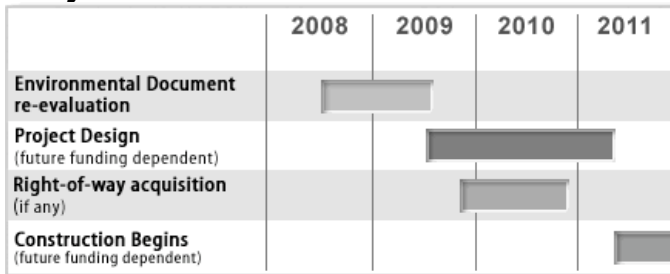
