

Glenn Highway MP 34-42 Reconstruction

Parks Highway to Old Glenn Highway ADOT&PF Project 58104/ Federal Project NH-0A1-5(24)


Project Scope

The Glenn Highway reconstruction project, Parks Highway to Old Glenn Highway, will reconstruct the Glenn Highway from milepost 34 to 42 to accommodate increasing traffic. It will add lanes, widen shoulders, accommodate turning movements at designated turn pockets, and add other traffic and safety improvements.

The Plans-In-Hand design (75% complete plans) was completed in April 2013. A re-evaluation of the 1993 Glenn Highway, Parks (MP 35) to MP 109 Environmental Assessment is on-going. Once the re-evaluation is approved by FHWA, the Right of Way acquisition will be able to begin. The final design of the project will parallel the Right of Way acquisition.

The project team is available to work with adjacent property owners on minor design refinements to minimize impacts.
