## **Glenn Highway MP 34-42 Projects**

# **FACT SHEET**

### **Project Scope**

The Glenn Highway Milepost (MP) 34-42
Reconstruction Project, Parks Highway to Old
Glenn Highway, has been split into three projects.
The first is the main reconstruction project that
consists of two lanes in each direction, frontage
road, and left/right turn lanes. The second project
will construct a pathway from Matanuska Lakes
State Recreation Area to Arctic Avenue. The third
project realigns the Colleen Street intersection and
extends a frontage road.

#### 1) Glenn Highway MP 34-42 Reconstruction

Project No. 0A15024/Z581040000

This reconstruction project will add lanes, widen

shoulders, add turn lanes and frontage roads, and add other traffic and safety related improvements. The final roadway will be a four-lane divided highway.

North Fishhook Road Glenn Highway MP 34-42 Reconstruction Project Bogard Rd Palmer-Wasilla Highway Arctic Ave 2 Glenn Parks to Old Glenn **Pathway Project** Parks Hwy Glenn/Parks Colleen Street Outer Springer Loop Rd Intersection and Frontage Road Project

The project is currently in the right-of-way appraisal and acquisition phase. The design phase of this project will continue and drawings are being developed to refine impacts to the affected environment, properties, and utilities. The project team is available to work with adjacent property owners on design refinements.

#### 2) Parks Highway to Old Glenn Highway Pathway

Project No. 0A15032/CFHWY00029

This pathway project will construct a 10-foot-wide separated pathway along the north side of the Glenn Highway from the Matanuska Lakes State Recreation Area and extending into Palmer. The environmental document is currently being prepared, with the final design anticipated to start in 2016.

#### 3) Colleen Street Intersection and Frontage Road

Project No. 0A15033/CFHWY00006

This project will realign Colleen Street and Grandview Road to a new signalized median opening on the Glenn Highway. It will also extend Grandview Road along the east side of the railroad tracks to consolidate access. The environmental document is currently being prepared, with the right-of-way appraisal and acquisition phase and final design anticipated to start in Summer 2016.

#### **Construction Schedule**

Construction for all three projects — 2018 to 2019 (depending on availability of funding and other factors)
