

KNIK-FAIRVIEW COMMUNITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE SOUTH TRUNK ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND A NO BUILD OPTION FOR NELSON ROAD EXTENSION WEST VIA LINLU LANE FOR ACCESS TO THE SOUTH PALMER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the existing Nelson Road, beginning at the Glenn Highway, is a substandard road and is unsuitable as a permanent route due to its long roundabout direction, routed through wetlands with an inadequate road foundation; and

WHEREAS, Trunk Road should be the first priority for construction and future main access to the South Palmer Elementary School (Machetanz Elementary School); and

WHEREAS, If a western access is necessary at a future date, then the route through Valley Block and Concrete (Proposed Sweeping Vista Subdivision), the Nelson Road East (the red route) is most appropriate, but not as a first construction action, South Trunk Road is preferable. Nelson Road extension west (the magenta route) is not suitable and should be a **NO BUILD** option.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Knik-Fairview Community Council recommends that the Trunk Road Extension South be expedited as much as possible before any other routes are developed; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that no decision be made at this time as to a west end access to the Ranch Subdivision and the South Palmer Elementary School (Machetanz Elementary School).
