RESOLUTION 09-08**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH REAL PROPERTY ASSET MANAGEMENT BOARD CONCERNING CONSTRUCTION OF A COLLECTOR ROAD [SOUTH TRUNK ROAD EXTENSION].

WHEREAS, rapid residential development has occurred, and is expected to continue to occur in the area east of Fairview Loop, south of the Parks Highway and west of the Parks/Glenn Highways Interchange; and

WHEREAS, a new elementary school has opened in the area in the fall of 2009 with initial bus service to be provided from the east via the existing Parks Highway frontage road from the Trunk Road overpass and continuing on Nelson Road; and

WHEREAS, a June 2009 Reconnaissance Report titled TRUNK ROAD EXTENSION SOUTH, MSB Project No. 35007, discusses routings to serve both ends of the area, with a single route identified from the Trunk Road Overpass south to a connection with Nelson Road and with four options to the west, of which three connect to Fairview Loop north of the existing Alaska Railroad and one connects to Fairview Loop just north of Lin Lu Lane; and

WHEREAS, provisions for safety, convenience and economy for both public and private interests require the development of a collector level road with connections to both the east and west ends of the area; and

WHEREAS, funding for both ends is either insufficient or non-existent to address the required construction, and it is necessary to set priorities for construction development.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Matanuska-Susitna Real Property Asset Management Board recommends the


Matanuska-Susitna Borough adopt a course of action consisting of:

- 1) adopting the east route identified as Trunk Road Extension (shown in the 2009 reconnaissance report as Figure C-5) and pursue funding and authority to construct that option.
- 2) continuing review of alternative routes and impacts for the western access from Fairview Loop.
